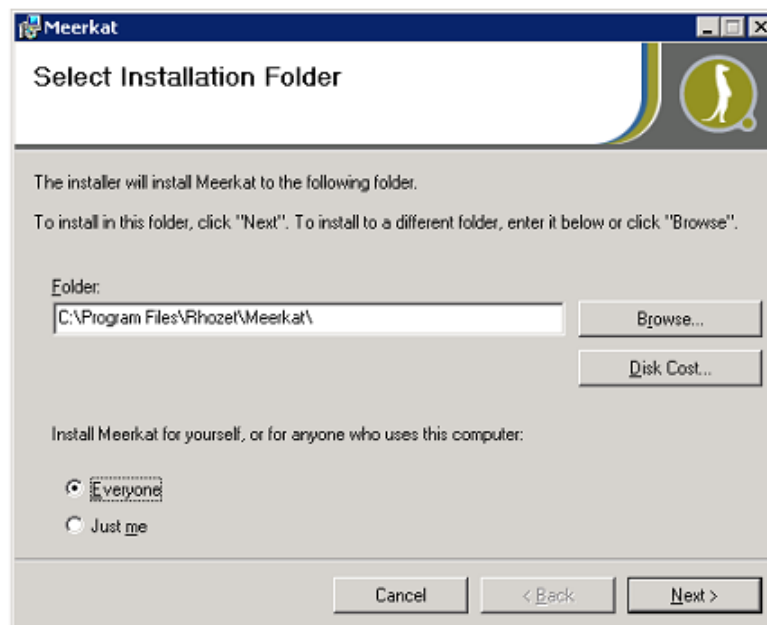


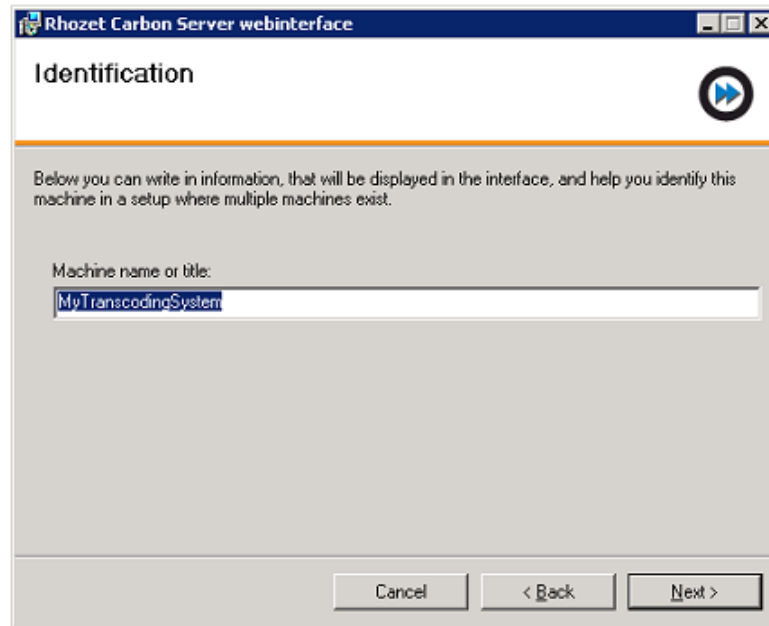
Upgrading to Carbon Server 2.x

Use the following steps to upgrade your copy of Carbon Server from any previous version of Carbon Server to Carbon Server 2.x.

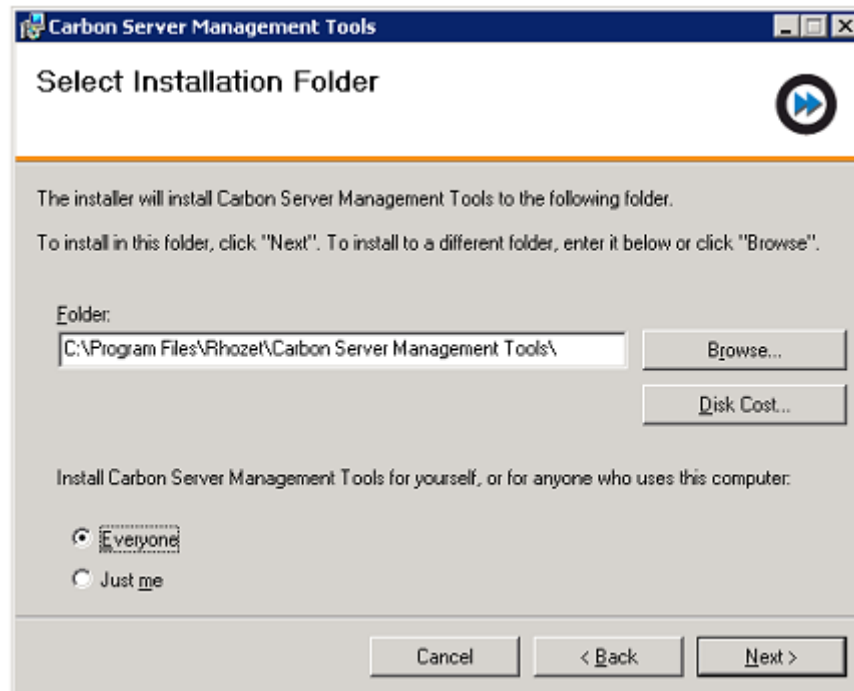
1. Exit any Rhozet application. If the Job Queue Manager is running in the systray right-click on the icon and click 'exit.'
2. Uninstall Carbon Server by clicking on 'Start -> Programs -> Rhozet -> Carbon Server Farm -> Uninstall Carbon Server Farm.' Follow the on-screen instructions.
3. **IMPORTANT:** Reboot the system when prompted by the Carbon Server installer.
4. Backup the following directories by **copying** them to a different location.
 - a. C:\Program Files\Common Files\Rhozet\CarbonServer Farm\User Presets\
 - b. C:\Program Files\Microsoft SQL Server\MSSQL\Data\
 - c. C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Application Data\Rhozet\CarbonServer Farm\Nexus\Watches\
5. Backup the registry, which contains all of your application settings by opening regedit, navigating to HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\RHOZET, right-click on the Carbon Server folder and choose export. Finally, choose a location to save the backup *.reg file.
6. Install the Carbon Server 2.x Farm Manager software from the \Setup_Server\setup.exe path on the Carbon Server 2.x CD.
7. **IMPORTANT:** Reboot the system when prompted by the Carbon Server installer.
8. Install the various components of the Carbon Server Web Interface.
 - a. Install Meerkat from the \WebComponents\Meerkat.msi path on the Carbon Server 2.x CD. NOTE: When asked, please choose the install for "Everyone" option.



- b. Install the Carbon Server Web Interface from the \\WebComponents\WebInterfaceSetup.msi path on the Carbon Server 2.x CD. You can accept the defaults for all of the settings. NOTE: The "Machine name or title" setting determines what is displayed in the browser title bar when a user is using the Web Interface.



- c. Install the Carbon Server Database Management tool from the \\WebComponents\CarbonServerManagementInstaller.msi path on the Carbon Server 2.x CD. As with Meerkat, please make sure to choose the install for "Everyone" option.



- d. Copy the file default.html from C:\inetpub\wwwroot\cs\ to C:\inetpub\wwwroot\

9. **IMPORTANT:** Reboot the system.

10. Update the Carbon Server Database
 - a. Run the Carbon Server Database Management tool by clicking 'Start -> All Programs -> Rhozet -> Carbon Server Tools -> Carbon Server Database Management
 - b. Click on the 'Update Database' tab.
 - c. Click the 'Update Database' button.
 - d. Look for the message that says "Database update complete successfully!"
 - e. Close Carbon Server Database Management

11. **IMPORTANT:** Reboot the system.

12. Upgrade and Configure Carbon Agents. Please see the Carbon Server Manual pgs. 15-16 to properly configure Carbon Agent.

NOTE: If you are using these directions to duplicate a Carbon Server install on a different machine you should now import the backup registry file you created in step 5. This will copy all of your existing application settings to the new install. It is very important that you **ONLY** do this between the exact same version of Carbon Server. Migrating settings to different versions of Carbon Server may cause serious problems with your installation.
